Das Park Hotel

Das Park Hotel located in Linz, Austria is actually a number of repurposed drainpipes(排水管) that have been turned into rooms. It's one of the greatest examples of how people can reuse materials. Since the space of each room is about 2 square meters, there are only a bed, light, power and ventilation(通风设备). You should pay for the bathroom and kitchen equipment. It uses a wonderful sound-proofing material to protect from being disturbed by the outer noise. The hotel is only available from May to October.

The Hobbit Motel

The Hobbit Motel can be found in Woodlyn Park, New Zealand. It is made of polystyrene(聚苯乙烯) blocks, which keep you warm in winter and cool in summer. Staying at the Hobbit Motel is a chance to enjoy Billy Black's Kiwi Culture Show. This performance draws people from all over the world and allows you to participate in the really unique New Zealand experience. The inside of the hotel is very cozy and homelike. The accommodation is clean, neat, with well-equipped kitchenette and all the bathroom facilities.

Romy McCloskey's mother who has passed away once said that butterflies were a sign she would always be with her. Decades later, those words helped McCloskey to perform a great act. As a fashion designer, she used her skills to repair the broken wing of a Monarch butterfly and shared the results online.

McCloskey started caring for Monarch butterflies this past autumn after finding a number of them in her backyard, and then she began to raise Monarch butterflies in memory of her mother. Recently, she found a three-day-old Monarch with a badly damaged wing, suffering the injury during its development. Most butterflies depend on their wings being the same shape to help in their flight, and with a lifespan of just two to six weeks, this Monarch had little chance of survival. Determined to help the broken Monarch, McCloskey thought she was up to the task after watching an instructional video on the procedure. "I figured, since I do so much designing, cutting and putting together of costumes... I could give this a go," she told *mymodernmet.com*.

McCloskey goes on to secure the Monarch with a bent wire hanger, cutting away the damaged pieces, which she says is "like cutting hair or nails" and causes no pain to the butterfly. After applying the wing from a dead butterfly she had found the week before, McCloskey shows the Monarch almost as good as new. "A quick spin around the backyard, then a little rest on one of the bushes... and then off he flew!" the designer said. "My heart soared with him, for sure!"

McCloskey said that she hopes the instructions will encourage others to help injured butterflies, but warns "that you have a steady hand or you could cause more harm than good."

The royal family is filled with rules, and one in particular might explain why Princess Charlotte is a princess, but her kids likely won't be.

When it comes to the British royal family, one thing is almost always true: they have a pretty

confusing set of official rules and protocols. For instance, the royal family doesn't have a last name. And don't forget the fact that Queen Elizabeth celebrates two birthdays every year.

If your head isn't swimming yet, consider the tradition of royal titles. As a British custom, only the daughter of a prince or a prince's wife may be considered a formal "princess". The latter applies to Kate, who is both a princess and the Duchess of Cambridge thanks to her marriage to Prince William, the Duke of Cambridge. And their children, Prince George and Princess Charlotte, also bear official royal titles because their father is Prince William.

However, while Prince George's future children will also carry their father's royal status, any children that Princess Charlotte has will not automatically be considered princes or princesses. Why? Royal custom dictates that royal titles are passed down via sons, but not daughters.

"Royal titles are inherited through sons, so if Princess Charlotte has children they would not automatically inherit the titles (his or her royal highness) HRH, Prince, or Princess," Lucy Hume, associate director of etiquette experts Debrett's, told Town&Country.

Of course, exceptions can (and will!) be made. (Learn about every time the British royal family broke their own protocol.) The Queen has offered HRH status to other royal offspring in the past, including the children of Queen Elizabeth's daughter, Anne. Although Princess Anne and her husband, Captain Phillips, declined, perhaps Princess Charlotte will be extended the same offer when her own children are born.

A ban on plastic bags came into force in Kenya on Monday in a bid to slow pollution and those found violating the new regulation could be given a maximum fine of 40,000 dollars or risk imprisonment of up to four years. The ban applies to the use, manufacture, and importation of plastic shopping bags.

The ban was first announced in February but postponed for six months to allow Kenyan consumers and shopkeepers to adjust to the new rules. However, some businessmen disagree with the ban, saying that jobs will be lost and that there will be difficulty earning a living. Dozens of countries in Africa have already adopted or announced bans on the use of plastic bags including Rwanda and Morocco, but Kenya's new law is particularly tough.

The plastic bags have long been identified as a major cause of environmental damage and health problems, killing birds, fish and other animals that mistake them for food. More than eight million tons of plastics drift into the ocean every year. The bags also damage agricultural land, pollute tourist sites and provide breeding grounds for the mosquitoes that carry malaria

and dengue fever. According to UN Environment Program, some 100 million plastic bags are handed out every year in Kenya by supermarkets alone. If we continue like this, by 2050, we will have more plastic in the ocean than fish, seriously affecting wildlife and tourism.

UNEP head Erik Solheim greeted the ban as "a huge, important step" to ending plastic pollution. He said, "Kenya is taking important action to remove an ugly stain on its outstanding natural beauty. It should be awarded for its environmental leadership. It's a great example that I hope will inspire others and help drive further commitments to the Clean Sea campaign."

3. 根据已知人物、事件及续写段落首句预测故事发展 (development)。故事总体的发展可能是 Steve 听进去了老师的那句“我关心你”，内心受到了极大的冲击，开始思考与改变。第一段续写根据首句“那天下午，Steve 满怀思绪地回家”可以推断这一天的回家过程一定有所不同。根据上文，Steve 父母是酒鬼，他讨厌待在家里，常常一个人去树林玩。所以那天下午回家之后他还是有可能去树林，但这一次一定是与学习有关。第二段续写根据首句“周一老师进行了测试”，可以预测这一次考试 Steve 的表现肯定出乎老师的预料，他应该通过了考试。
