Is zoo life really bad for elephants? Are they really healthier when they walk around free? People talk about these questions for years.

Now researchers (研究者) give scientific evidence (证据) that elephants who walk around free are healthier and live longer than those in zoos. This finding answers a lot of questions about the health of elephants, and it might also bring about some changes in the world's zoos.
