However, things are different in the UK. British people are also known to drink tea. But the UK has the unusual tradition of afternoon tea, where the tea is served with light sandwiches and small cakes. Friends usually gather together to share tea in their leisure time, which also strengthens the friendship. Today, most people in the UK use tea bags rather than tea leaves.
