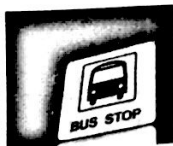

CrossFit is a difficult physical exercise, and it is now the most popular exercise in P. E. classes at Waukegan High School. It has been popular over last 16 years and has more than one million fans.

Schools in Chicago use CrossFit to catch the attention of students, especially those who have weight problems. And most say it really works compared with traditional gym classes.

"I think it's a great way to teach kids to keep fit, especially those who aren't interested in soccer or basketball," said Tracy Haraf, a teacher. "They think it's hard, but I think they have a lot of fun doing it."

Alexus Wiltz, 18, said the workout made her do better in the basketball matches. "Because of CrossFit, I am faster and pay more attention, and my defending (防守) is becoming better," she said after a class. "It's really helpful to me."

But some doctors are worried. The exercise is so difficult that students may get hurt, especially when they haven't enough experience. Dr. Craig Finlayson holds such an opinion too. Strength (力量) training is fine for kids, but heavy weights can be trouble for them. They might hurt themselves by trying to do too much.

However, other people have a different idea. Greg Moisio is a gym teacher in a two-campus school. He says about 650 kids in his school take CrossFit each day. With good training methods, the students won't get hurt easily. CrossFit spokesman (发言人) Russell Berger said, "CrossFit is not dangerous. Anyone can learn to do it safely."

Children returning to school are now more likely to get a tablet device (平板设备) than a pencil case, according to a study.

Researchers found that 55 percent of children are given a new iPad as they head back to school, compared to only 45 percent who get a new pencil case.

It also showed fewer kids walk to school now, dropping from 81 percent in their parents' schooldays to just 63 percent now, with a third of kids preferring to use a scooter (滑板车) to make it to the school gates.

And most children now listen to music on the way to school instead of chatting with friends as their parents used to. However, one thing that hasn't changed about going back to school is the excitement.

68 percent of parents said they rushed back to school to be with friends they hadn't seen for the six-week break. Only 23 percent of children rush back to school to chat with friends now.

This is because modern kids chat with friends during the holiday on WeChat or QQ, so they already know what their schoolmates have been up to.

Clothes are another big area of change. Children like to choose clothes on their own now. What's more, their clothes are always in style.

The after-school life has also changed. More than half of parents had a daily bedtime story in their childhood, while a third of modern children watch daily cartoons on the Internet instead now.
