Finding enough meat was a problem for primitive man and, keeping it for times when it was scarce was just as hard. Three ways were found to keep meat from spoiling : salting , drying, and freezing.

People near salty waters salted their meat. At first they probably put dry salt on it, but this kept only the outside. Later they may have pickled their meat by putting it in salt water.

In hot, dry places, men found that they could eat meat that had dried while it was still on the bones .They later learned to cut meat into thin pieces and put it up to dry in the hot air.

Men in cold places found that frozen meat didn't spoil. They could leave their meat outside and eat it when they pleased.

A new study has found that the best way to make yourself feel happier is to think of something good that happened to you the day before.

Volunteers who were asked to remember a pleasant event from past 24 hours began to feel happier right away. Other activities such as saying “Thank you” and smiling also made volunteers feel happier, but not as much.

Professor Richard Wiseman of Hertfordshire University planned the study. He got 26,000 people to go online to try out a few different activities to make them feel happier. They were told to be nice, remember a pleasant event from the day before, give thanks or smile for 15 seconds twice a day. The volunteers did these activities for one week.

The result showed that thinking about one good thing that had happened the day before worked the best for making people happier.

Geena David knew she wanted to be a movie star when she was very young. She was not sure what gave her the idea, but she wanted to look like a movie star. “I have a lot of pictures from my childhood of me wearing sunglasses,” she says. “I used to wear them to watch TV.”

Early movie actors started wearing sunglasses not because they looked good, but because their eyes hurt. The lights used on movie sets were extremely bright and could cause a painful problem known as “Klieg eyes”. It was named after the Klieg brothers who invented the lights. Actors wore sunglasses to give their eyes a rest. But when movie stars began wearing their sunglasses in public, they quickly became a must.

Eventually actors started wearing sunglasses in their movies as well as on the street. Audrey Hepburn wore ultra-cool Ray-Ban sunglasses in the 1961 movie, *Breakfast at Tiffany’s*. As a result, Ray-Ban sunglasses started to appear more and more in the movies. In 1979, Ray-Ban “Wayfarers” were worn by Jake and Elwood in *The Blue Brothers*. Tom Cruise wore Ray-Ban “Aviator” sunglasses in the 1986 hit, *Top Gun*. Then in 1997, Will Smith and Tommy Lee Jones made Ray-Ban “Predator” sunglasses famous in *Men in Black*.

Of course sunglasses aren’t just a fashion statement. The main reason to wear sunglasses is to protect our eyes against UV radiation. UV radiation can damage our eyes, so people now choose their sunglasses carefully. But you don’t have to give up style for safety. The choice of frames and lenses available these days is huge. So you can protect your eyes and still be the coolest person on the beach.

The First Lesson of the New Term, a TV program about how to protect oneself in times of emergency, is meant to provide school students with the knowledge on self-protection. It will help students in case of natural disasters such as earthquakes, fires, snowstorms or floods. Many examples show that enough knowledge about self-protection along with enough courage and willpower (意志力) can help many survive (幸存,活下来).

The most recent example is from the earthquake in Sichuan Province in May of 2008. While thousands of school kids were killed by collapsed (倒塌的) school buildings, all students from a middle school survived even without a single one being hurt. That's because of their timely and orderly evacuations (撤离), which they had been drilled (训练) in every term.
