As we know, air pollution is very serious in the world now. Cars and buses have polluted the air. More and more people pay attention to it. They are trying to do something to reduce it. Bicycle sharing systems(系统) are among them.

Bicycle sharing systems are also known as yellow bicycle programs, white bicycle programs, public bikes, or free bikes. They are popular in Europe now. Paris has the world's largest urban(城市的) cycle rent system.

Paris will become "a green capital of bikes" and they plan to park 20,000 bicycles at 1,600 stations. Paris takes this plan to improve the city traffic environment and reduce the waste gas displacement(废气排量).

At a rent station, you only need to put your credit card(信用卡) into the machine to rent a bike, and it provides French, German, English and Chinese service. If you ride the bike for only 30 minutes to relax, you don't have to pay for it. A two-hour bike rent costs you 4 Euros(欧元).

Riding a bike instead of taking a bus or a taxi can not only save energy and money, but also reduce air pollution and improve traffic environment. It can help you keep healthier too. Why not join them?
