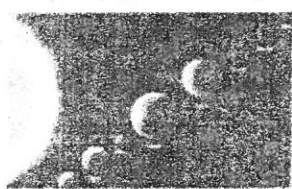

On a cold afternoon in January 2015, Yesenia Diosdado, 11, got off a school bus in Lenexa, Kansas, near the building where she lives with her family. When the bus went away, Yesenia saw police and doctors taking care of the wounded people of a three-car accident that took place at a busy corner nearby. Yesenia joined a small crowd of people who were watching it across the street.

She noticed that a wounded woman was trying to communicate with an doctor using sign language(手语), but he couldn't understand her. "I heard him ask for a translator (译员)," Yesenia says.

She ran over to the doctors to help—her mother, a sign language translator, had taught her and her family members how to sign, although no one in the family has hearing problems.

"I sign. Can I help?" Yesenia offered to help. The woman said, "I dropped on the ground." Yesenia was able to describe the situation that the woman's neck was hurt and told them the name of the local hospital the woman preferred. "She looked really hurt," says Yesenia. "I'm proud that I got to do something to help."

When her mother, Susan Milidore, 36, heard about Yesenia's hero story, she wasn't surprised. "It's in her nature to help," says Susan. "I was surprised that she realised the seriousness of the situation and did something for it. Most grown-ups wouldn't do that."

A few weeks later, Yesenia Diosdado received a gold coin and a certificate of appreciation (嘉许证书) from the government at her school.

"When I was young, my mom always said that you never know when sign language might help."

says Yesenia. "That day, it did."

Emergencies (紧急情况) don't happen very often. But when they do, you want to get help first. No one wants to spend time looking up the phone numbers.

In 1968, the United States government wanted one number that people could call for emergencies. They decided that 911 was easy to remember and people could dial it quickly. The very first 911 call was made on February 16, 1968 in Alabama. Today, 911 is used for emergencies in most parts of the United States and many parts of Canada.

Other countries may use other numbers. In Great Britain, it's 999. If you're not sure which emergency number is used in your area, check your phone book.

When to call

Never call 911 as a joke or just to see what might happen. The only time you should call 911 is

when a person is badly hurt in danger right now! So call when there is a fire, a car accident or sudden sickness, etc.

When in an emergency call

When you dial the 911 operator (接线员), it's always OK to give out your information. Speak slowly and clearly when you explain what's happening. What happened? Where are you? Who needs help?

Don't hang up (挂断)!

If you have to call 911, do not hang up until the operator tells you it's OK to do so. That way, you can be sure that the operator has all the information to offer help fast.
