Why does your dog shake when it's all wet? It isn't just 66 (try) to get you and your homework wet. There's a good reason 67 the shaking.

The short answer is: they're wet. But there's actually more to it than that.

In an article in *Journal of the Royal Society Interface*, Andrew Dickerson and others at the Georgia Institute of Technology in the US take 68 look at this strange problem. The 69 (researcher) record the shaking characteristics (特点) of 33 animals, 70 (include) five types of dogs.

It turns out that mammals (哺乳动物) save a large amount of energy by shaking to dry themselves off. 71 they do not shake, animals have to use up to 20 percent of their 72 (day) energy simply to dry themselves.

And 73 (near) all furry (多毛的) mammals shake to dry themselves. Those that don't, like kangaroos, usually live in desert climates where staying dry isn't very hard.

But not all animals shake at the same rate (频率). 74 (small) animals seem to shake more quickly. A mouse shakes 30 times per second, while bears, tigers and big dogs shake only about four.

Dickerson and his team discover that these animals do this job as efficiently as possible. In each case, the animals shake off about 70 percent of the water on their 75 (body) in seconds. For us to dry our hair, it takes us not seconds but minutes!

第三节 信息归纳(共5小题;每小题2分,满分10分)

阅读下面短文,根据其内容完成表格中所缺的信息。

When throwing away rubbish, do you know which bin it should go into? Have you ever noticed the differently-colored bins on the street?

Some of you might not be able to answer this question. However, it's quite important to know how to sort (分类) your waste. Not knowing how to sort the waste can make it harder to save energy and protect the environment. If you don't sort your waste, all of it will go to a landfill (垃圾填埋池) and be buried (埋葬) together. These landfills can take up large areas of ground that could be used for planting trees. The electronic waste you throw away, such as batteries (电池), can pollute the land and groundwater. Other pieces of rubbish, like the metal part of a pen, can be used to make into other things if they are properly recycled.

With this in mind, our school is now requiring every student to form a habit of sorting the waste. Here in our schoolyard we lay four different colors of rubbish bins for different kinds of rubbish. The red is for harmful waste which includes things like medicine, batteries and so on. The blue is for waste like paper, metal, glass and other things that can be recycled. The green is for kitchen waste which is known as wet waste, such as food and soup left after having meals. The yellow is for other dry waste like plastic bags. Dry waste is not wet, recyclable or harmful.
