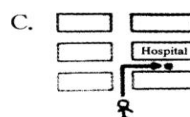
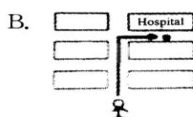
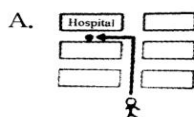

A moneylender’s greedy condition 《威尼斯商人》

The Merchant of Venice is a play written by British author William Shakespeare. In the play a young man named Bassanio falls in love with a girl named Portia. He needs money to marry her, but he has no money. So he turns to his friend Antonio for help. But Antonio doesn’t have enough money, either. He plans to borrow some money from a moneylender (放债者) named Shylock. Shylock, who is heartless and greedy (贪婪的), agrees to lend the money, but only on one condition. What condition is it? Let’s read the following story together.

“Shylock!” yelled Antonio. “Are you going to lend us the money or not? Answer me!”

Shylock answered him slowly. “Do you remember all of those times that you insulted (侮辱) me in a loud voice that everyone could hear? You once spat (吐口水) on me and called me a dog. And now you want to borrow money from me, a dog!”

“Look! I’m not asking you a favor. You can charge me any interest (利息) you want. I don’t mind. My ships will arrive any day now.”

“All right, Antonio. I’m willing to lend you the money. I won’t even charge you any interest. Just pay me back on time.”

Antonio couldn’t believe his ears. “What did you say?”

“I said you didn’t know me. You always call me a cheapskate (守财奴), but I am not. I will help you. I won’t even charge you a single ducat (达克特, 以前欧洲的一种钱币). However, there’s something I’m worried about. What if you don’t pay me back?”

“Don’t worry, Shylock. I’ll pay you back.”

“Well, I need some kind of a guarantee (保证), don’t I? Three thousand ducats is a lot of

money. If you don't pay me back on time, I want a pound of flesh (肉). I'll take a pound of flesh from any part of your body."

Antonio didn't like what Shylock said. "No. I'd rather pay some interest if I'm late on the payment."

"I'm afraid that's no good," said Shylock as he laughed. "Do you think I'd take money from another moneylender? Besides, this agreement is only a joke! Do you think that any lawyer or judge (法官) would believe me? Would they really believe that I want a pound of your flesh? You don't have to worry about anything!"

Antonio agreed to the condition. The three men went to a lawyer and signed an agreement.

The *campus convenience store* (校园小卖部) is a place where many students enjoy a snack and a chat. However, it may become a thing of the past.

China’s educational and health authorities(当局) have announced to close convenience stores in all schools across the country. The regulation(规定) has taken effect since April 1, 2019. It requires that schools should record each meal and solve any food problem as soon as possible. Parents can also eat with students at school and give suggestions to the school on food safety and nutrition(营养).

The regulation raised heated discussions. Many students were sad. They thought that without convenience stores, their campus life will be less interesting. However, many parents expressed support for the regulation. The father of a junior school student said that cheap, low-quality snacks sold at these stores were harmful to children’s health. A teacher said that students rushed to shops to buy snacks as soon as a class was over, which influenced the normal teaching order.

The regulation also requires schools to monitor students who may be too fat, and try to make sure they follow a healthy diet.

And in fact many foreign countries have their own ways to make students eat healthily. For example, many parents in Australia volunteer in schools. They, at least, do their best to see that their children are served nutritious food. In Japan, there is food and nutrition education. Students eat lunch in their classrooms, where they learn about diet and nutrition, and Japan’s

food culture. They also take turns serving meals to each other, cleaning up, and recycling. This helps children get ‘a sense of gratitude(感恩)’ and ‘appreciate (欣赏、尊重)foods and social manners’ .

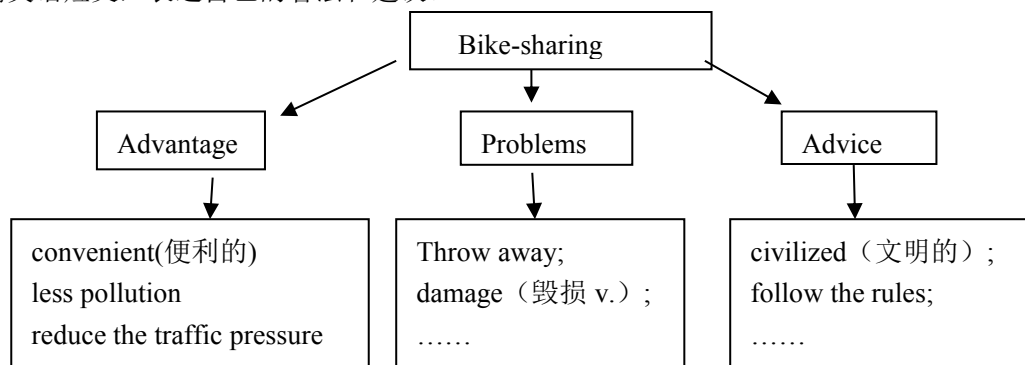
