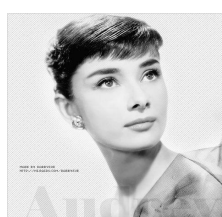

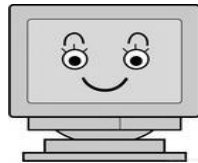

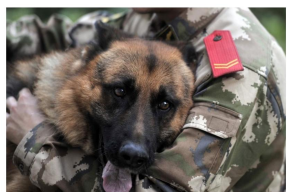

How does a police department build a small army of detective dogs as smart as Sherlock Holmes? It's easy, just __36__ clone the best dog of these dogs. It's reported that more and more people choose cycling instead of driving to schools, to workplaces or to do sightseeing. The introduction of Bike-sharing Plans, pioneered by companies like Ofo and Mobike, has brought the trend to a new level.

People can unlock the shared bikes by simply using their smartphone. The bikes are equipped with GPS and can be left anywhere in public for the next user. They're popular among many Chinese people as they provide an effective solution to the "last mile" problem, which refers to the final leg of a person's journey.

"In places where the underground doesn't extend (延伸到), where it's difficult to change from one kind of transport to another, it's so easy to get where you want to go with Mobike," Hu Hong, 29, told AFP. She pedals to her faraway job in Shanghai.

However, the schemes have also led to problems such as illegal parking, vandalism (故意破坏) and theft.

"Bike-sharing is a greener method of transportation and provides a user-friendly experience," said Liu Xiaoming, vice-minister of transport. "But it's a combination of online and offline business. Operators are usually strong in online services, but lack offline business experience, which causes problems."

To deal with these problems, the company came up with the idea of encouraging people to return the bikes to stations by rewarding free time for their next rides.

Now, Chinese service operators are also trying to address these problems. For example, Mobike sets a 100-point credit score for each user, with points taken in the case of bad behavior. Once a score drops below 80, bike rental is increased to 100 yuan per 30 minutes, up from 0.5-1 yuan.

Many Chinese girls love "small, fresh meat", which refers to young, effeminate(女人气的) male stars. However, not everyone is a fan of them. On Sept. 6, an article described some male stars as too effeminate.

This came after CCTV was criticized for inviting several young male stars to perform on *First Class* for the New Semester, an educational TV show for primary and secondary school students, which aired 5days earlier. After that, many parents left comments online, saying the stars in the show had a bad influence on their children.

The popularity of effeminate male stars is partly down to the influence of Japanese and South Korean pop culture, an expert told China Daily. However, the “femininity” of males isn't a recent social phenomenon. In fact, being effeminate was popular among Chinese men centuries ago.

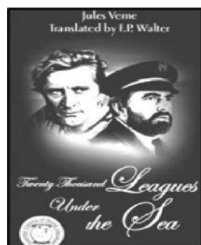
Indeed, the debate about effeminate male stars has been going on for a while. In July, a Hong Kong singer said during the singing reality show *Sing! China* that he feels tired of seeing effeminate male stars. “It isn't that they're not good, but we should discover ourselves.”He said during the show.

His opinion was shared by a Chinese director. “Some young actors are feminine and they should be more manly,” he said.

Deng Xiquan, head of the Youth Research Institute at the China Youth and Children Research Center, believes such a phenomenon is completely natural.“It will be replaced by a new youth culture at some stage. If a man has feminine beauty, this doesn't mean that he lacks responsibility,” Deng told China Daily. Deng's opinion was echoed by the People's Daily.“A man's strength should be judged on the basis of their inner qualities - not their physical appearance,” it wrote.

Blood donation, also called blood banking, is a meaningful thing to do. It is an easy and direct way to contribute to social work and help the community. It helps to save lives and helps those who lose blood during operation or in accidents.

You are able to give or donate blood every three or four months. It is a great way to make a big difference to someone's life and you can always be proud of it after making valuable contributions to society. Blood donation is not a big problem, but you need to keep a few points in mind.

Before donating blood, make sure that the ferrum (铁) level in your body is high enough and for that you should take a healthy diet. For making hemoglobin(血红蛋白) in your body up to standard. drink lots of juice and other drinks. Fruit juice, such as apple juice, is very good for increasing the blood level in your body. For a good blood flow in your body, drink at least 6~7 glasses of water every day. It's not wise to drink wine before or after giving blood. Do not smoke half an hour before giving blood.

When you are going for blood donation, be relaxed, which helps keep the right blood pressure. While donating blood, take a deep breath and try to calm yourself. Don't take part in some other activities.

Blood donation is a very simple and fast process, but you need to take care of yourself after donating blood. Proper care helps to reduce bad effects. The following are a few tips that will help you out.

Take a rest for 15 minutes after the donation. It helps you to relax yourself.

Make sure that you have meals after donating blood. Smoking shouldn't be allowed for one hour after the process. Don't do any activities right away, for example, driving.

Finally, be proud of yourself because you have done a great thing in helping to save someone's life. Blood donation is a very important activity.

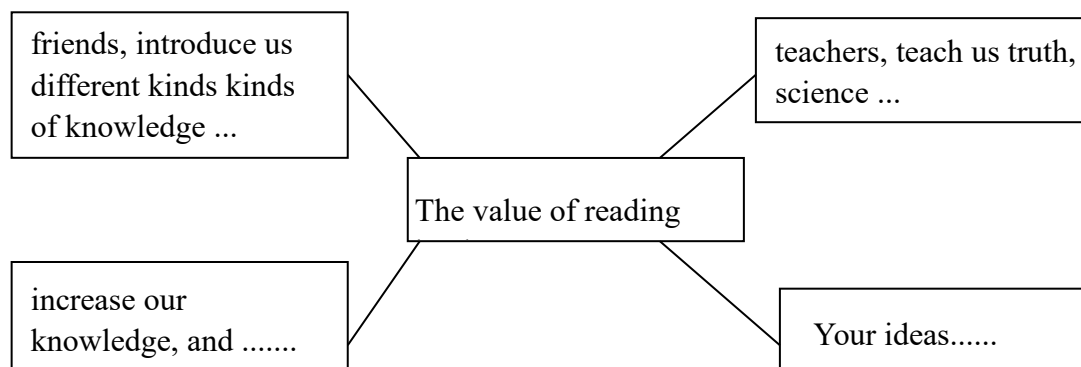
