WAYS TO STAY HEALTHY

As we all face the novel coronavirus, protecting yourself is the same as protecting others. Here are some safety suggestions based on the Handbook for the Prevention and Treatment of COVID-19, which was released by WeDoctor Digital General Hospital.

● Stay away from crowds and wear masks

If you have to go to crowded places, remember to mask up. Keep at least one meter of distance between yourself and other people, particularly those who are coughing or sneezing.

● Stay ventilated

Keep proper indoor ventilation (通风) while at home. Open windows to let in fresh air during the day. It's best to do this three times a day for 15 minutes to half an hour each time.

● Keep up good habits

Keep healthy habits such as eating a balanced diet and exercising regularly, as well as getting enough sleep.

● Wash hands properly

Remember to wash your hands before eating, after going to the bathroom, coming home, coming into contact with garbage and touching animals. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth before washing your hands.

C

On Jan 26, people around the world were shocked to hear of the sudden passing of Kobe Bryant, one of the NBA's most legendary (传奇性的) players. The 41-year-old, his 13-year-old daughter Gianna Bryant and seven others died when their helicopter crashed in California, US.

People from all walks of life have paid tribute (敬意) to the late basketball superstar – not just for his achievements on the court, but for his genuine (真诚的) personality and the inspiration (激励) he provided to so many people.

In the basketball world, Bryant ranks among the top players of all time. Fans remember him as the player who helped the Los Angeles Lakers win five NBA championships during his 20-year-long career. He started out as a basketball prodigy (神童) who skipped college and took his talents directly to the NBA. His deadly agility (敏捷) and aggressive tactics (进攻性的策略) earned him the nickname Black Mamba (进攻性极强的一种非洲毒蛇). That's why his competitive philosophy (哲学) is known as the "Mamba Mentality".

"Mamba Mentality is you're going, you're competing, you're not worried about the end result," Bryant said. "It's all about focusing on the process and trusting in the hard work when it matters most."

Off the court, he was known as a successful businessman, buying stakes (股份) in several companies, including Alibaba and Dell. He also left footprints in the movie industry, winning an Oscar in 2018 with his short film Dear Basketball.

He was also known as a proud family man. His friend, baseball star Derek Jeter, remembered him as such in an essay: "Throughout our friendship, the most meaningful conversations we had – they were always about family."

As the Los Angeles Times noted, Bryant's greatness was cemented (强化) by his skill, hard work and tireless pursuit of victory. His legacy (留给后人的东西) will live on long after his death.

The novel coronavirus (新冠病毒) made this year's Spring Festival holiday very different for most of us.

Many places in China began a first-level emergency (突发事件) response to the virus in mid-January, calling for people to stay at home. Following these rules, most people gave up family gatherings during the Spring Festival and canceled any festive celebrations.

"It's the quietest Chinese New Year I've ever had," said Xin Jingrong, a 14-year-old student from Nanning, Guangxi. For the first time in years, Xin's grandmother had to cancel her trip to Nanning and stay alone in her hometown.

The control measures not only separate many families, but also make daily life inconvenient. Many shops are closed, delivery services are slow, and wearing masks in public has become a must. But despite the inconvenience, people are showing their understanding and cooperation (合作).

Tong Zexi, a 15-year-old student from Harbin, has not gone out in more than 20 days. “I know I need to protect myself and cause no trouble. In this critical (关键的) time, when one gets sick, many others could be affected.”

Apart from simply following the rules, some people have done amazing things to help fight the outbreak.

On Feb 3, Zhao Junyan, a Junior 2 student from Shanghai, brought 15,000 masks from Indonesia back to China, People’s Daily reported. Zhao, while traveling in Jakarta, collected the masks with his uncle, who works in the city. The 15-year-old donated (捐赠) all of the masks to Cangnan, Zhejiang, his hometown.

“When a country is in trouble, everyone is responsible to help,” Zhao said to the media. “What I have done is what an ordinary Chinese person can possibly do.”

There are seven types of sea turtles in the world, and Sri Lanka is home to five of them. In recent years, due to the destruction (破坏) of the local marine (海洋的) environment and Sri Lanka’s coastal (沿海的) development, the sea turtles are being challenged with surviving. More sea turtles are being accidentally injured by fishing boats and marine garbage, as well as intentionally (故意地) injured by people.

Chamara Indika, 35, grew up on the beach and saw all of this happen. In the beginning, he worked to protect sea turtles as a volunteer. He used his spare time to spread related knowledge, but later found that a single person’s power was not enough. By chance, he met Jack Xiao, the founder of YIK International Volunteer (YIKIV) from China, and they decided to work together.

In 2016, Chamara set up the Nil Manel Foundation. YIKIV brought volunteers from all over the world to Sri Lanka and the Nil Manel Foundation provided professional training and guidance to the volunteers. The foundation also taught them about turtle/ocean protection and carried out protection efforts. The volunteers are expected to spread their knowledge to more people.

Their efforts have paid off. The turtles' survival rate is the highest it has ever been, and more people are aware of protecting them.

What has impressed Chamara most is the young volunteers who come from China along with their parents. There was one young volunteer who told his mom, "Mom, I won't use straws (吸管) or plastic bags anymore," because many sea turtles eat plastic bags and die.

This has made Chamara feel satisfied. "It's not enough to rely on my own strength and one generation," he told TEENS. "I want to pass it on from generation to generation." And he did it.
