“The meat of masked civets(果子狸)can be eaten and has long been considered a rare valuable meat from the mountain,” says the Animal Encyclopedia (百科全书)for Children, a science book published by Wuhan University Press.

But following the outbreak of the novel coronavirus, which has been related to meat of wild animals, a reader wrote online that the description was not good; the press replied by stopping the book from all shops.

The action is welcomed, as some research shows the virus came from dead bats, while others doubt it might have been transmitted from bats to pangolins(穿山甲)and from them to humans. Whichever animal was the host, researchers are in agreement that meat from wild animals is not safe for eating, which caused the SARS epidemic(非典病毒疫情)in 2003, should be taken off menus.

However, this alone cannot help. Without a law in place, one cannot stop restaurants from

serving wild animal meat, even though researchers know the dangers they have.

The first step is to build agreement. Education is important: only when everyone realizes the dangers of eating wild animal meat will they give up the habit and build the law.

And such knowing should begin early. Teaching children from a young age not to eat wild animals will make it easier to ensure they keep away from doing so when they grow up.

The Wuhan University Press encyclopedia has been stopped from shops, but that is because the press is located in Wuhan. It is hoped that other press houses across the country look through their published books and make similar actions. "Saying NO to wild animal meat" in children's reading material is a good way to begin.

As the new corona-virus disease forces students to stay home, online learning has seen a big rise among students. Since late January, China has put off starting the new school term and encouraged students to study at home over safety.

The Ministry of Education published a guideline for universities to have online classes, with 22 online platforms offering 24,000 courses to students. Online course companies also took special actions to meet students' needs for online learning during this period, such as free courses and online question-answering services.

Besides what has been arranged (安排) by your schools as your study list, what can you gain from online learning? Online courses can offer you a good experience for self-learning.

To successfully learn online, you need to plan your time well, come to class on time, concentrate while studying and fully stick to your learning process, just as you would do at school.

To stay on track with your online course, always keep in mind what you hope to finish by the end of it. Make a goal. Count how much time each task will take to finish. Keep notes carefully and review them often.

A study plan is important to online learning. First, you need to plan ahead with a good time

table. Online learning needs to be well organized. Create a study list that will help you remember all the important dates like online exams or deadlines for your homework. A to-do list is useful to do your study plan first and to follow and check with your studying.

When you feel yourself losing concentration, consider taking a short break or stopping for the night. It is better to wait until you are able to make a fresh start rather than waste your time trying to focus. Taking online courses can be very convenient for many people. However, online learning requires time management skills, self-discipline,(自律) willpower and motivation(动机), as it may be challenging for online learners to successfully finish their online courses.

As American author John C. Maxwell once said, “Success doesn’t just happen. You have to be intentional about it, and that takes discipline.” Take Maxwell’s advice and make full use of online learning for self-improvement.
