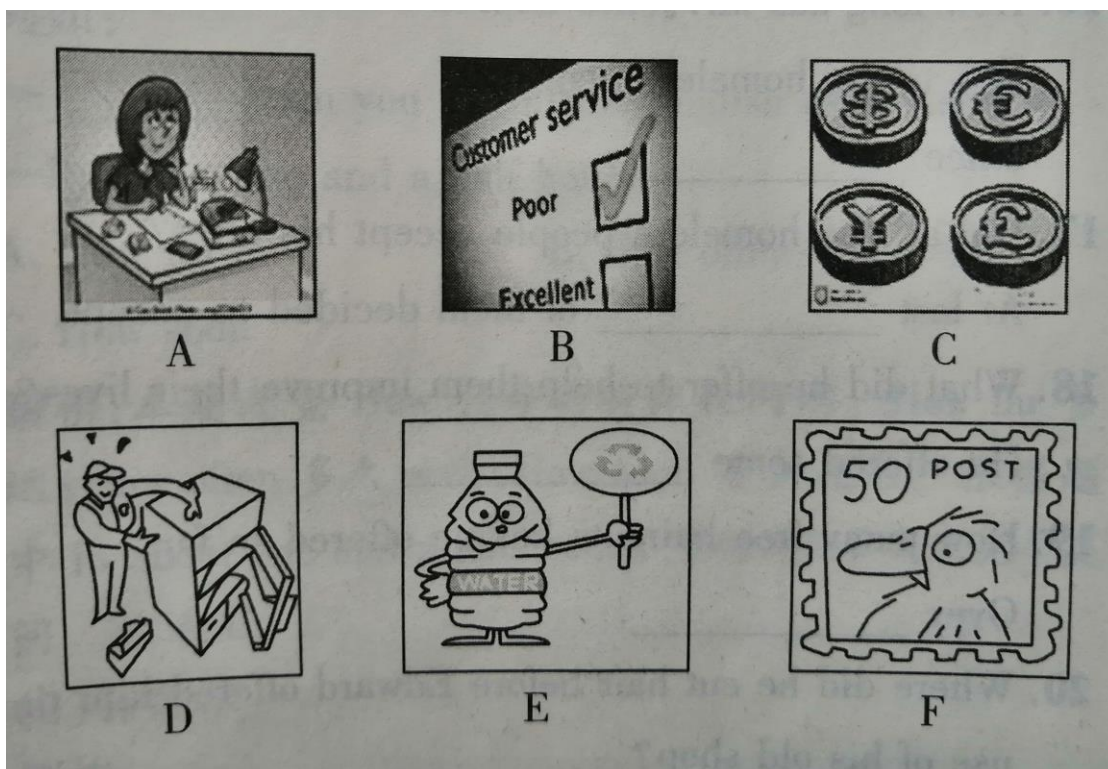

Los Angeles is known as a driving town. As the Missing Persons' song goes, "Nobody walks in L.A." In the city, people are so busy driving to work. Even for the usual shopping, it's hard to see people waling in the street.

Chuck McCarthy wants to change it! The actor gave up the job of earning money. And he has a new special job now---"people walker". The idea for the business came when he wanted to make some more money." I thought about walking dogs at first, but I didn't want to pick up dog poop(粪便). That's less interesting." Many customers need the special service because they are lonely, or they enjoy the feeling of being safe." My words are full of friendship and warmth, but I can tell you that they are conversations, not one-sided monologue（独白）."

Just walking and talking and knowing that someone is listening can be helpful for most people. They were very pleased with McCarthy's job because he listened to them. He walks with others for \$7 per mile (around 50 yuan per kilometer).

B

The FIVB World Cup Tournament was held in Japan from Sept.14 to 29,2019, and 12 teams played in a round-robin format. China won the gold medal with a perfect 11-0 record on Sept.29.

Though they had got their title with a 3-0 win over Serbia on September 28, China stuck to regular starters to play against Argentina. Gong Xiangyu scored a game-high 15 points. Yuan Xinyue added 13 to the 25-17, 25-14, 25-12, followed by Zhu Ting with 12 points.

“Every one of our team has made progress and we have greater teamwork, ”team leading scorer Zhu told Xinhua.

Even the coach Lang Ping, who kept perfect calm from time to time throughout the match, couldn't hold back her tears facing the camera in the mixed zone.

“Although the World Cup does not serve as Olympic qualification this year, it's still a matter of the greatest importance to us, ”Chinese coach Lang Ping said. “This is the best chance for us to prepare for the Tokyo Olympic Games in 2020.”

President Xi Jinping sent a congratulatory message on Sept.29 to the Chinese Women's Volleyball Team, after they got the World Cup title. "The Chinese team has successfully defended its World Cup crown with 11 straight victories, winning great honors for the country and the Chinese people,” said Xi. The players didn't fear any opponents and fought hard with both style and skills, showing excellent teamwork and a hard-working spirit, added the President. “Therefore I would extend my warm congratulations and sincere greetings to you, ”he said.

It is reported that the training of the Chinese Women's Volleyball Team started this year on February 10th. After more than 7 months of training and competition, the Chinese team ended up winning the year with the champion. This is the tenth

“three-competition” champion of the Chinese Women’s Volleyball Team.

China is only the third country in the world to own a positioning system. Only the United States and Russia have already developed their GPS or Glonass. ____52____ With it, the country no longer has to rely on foreign systems. It also shows the world that China has made much technological progress.

Work on the Beidou project began in 1994. However, the first two Beidou satellites were not sent into space until 2000. ____53____ These satellites have formed a global network. China has been practicing the rule that asks people to use their real names when registering(注册) for Internet service. The rules also ask Internet companies operating in China to remove the untrue information which the web users ever gave.

Chinese lawmakers passed the rule on December 28th, 2012, at the end of a five-day meeting of the Standing Committee of the NPC.

The new rules say network service providers must well check up the information given by users. The providers have been ordered to stop the spread of illegal (违法的) information, and take steps to deal with the problem. The Xinhua News says those

steps include removing the information from the Internet and then reporting it to the government.

Chinese officials say the rules are aimed at protecting the personal information of Internet users and stopping false information such as junk e-mail. However, some people say such new real-name rules will make people less likely to report illegal actions for fear of possible action against them.

Duncan Clark is an adviser to Stanford University's Graduate School of Business. He lives in Beijing. He says, "For a long time we've seen the Internet being used to report illegal action, but the new rules seem to stop those reports."

But the good news is through real-name registration the Internet crime among teenagers will be controlled.
