The Coronavirus whistleblower Dr. Li Wenliang died of the virus on the night of February 6th. The 34-year-old doctor was working as an ophthalmologist(眼科医生) at Wuhan Central Hospital when he sent out a warning to fellow medics on December 30th. He was one of the first eight doctors who warned of the new virus and was blamed in early January by local police for “publishing rumors(谣言).” He first posted about the coronavirus in his medical schoolmate WeChat group. “I only wanted to remind my university classmates to be careful,” he said. The Wuhan doctor is widely regarded as a hero, and a number of posts on Chinese social media sites have expressed **grief** over his death.

I still remember how badly I wanted to be invisible when they laughed at me.

In high school I got more involved in sports and arts. By this time everyone at my school was used to my height, but if I went out of town, people would comment about my appearance. They canted like I couldn’t hear them.

He never talked about himself as an object of sympathy, nor did he show any envy of the more fortunate or able. What he looked for in others was a “good heart”, and if he found one, the owner was good enough for him. I believe that is a proper standard by which we can judge people, even though I still don’t know exactly what “a good heart” is.

Unable to engage in many activities, my father still tried to **participate** in some way.

I now know he participated in some things indirectly through me, his only son. When I played ball, he “played” too. When I joined the Navy, he “joined” too. And when I came home on leave, he saw to it that I visited his office. Introducing me, he was really saying, “This is my son, but it is also me, and I could have done this, too, if things had been different.” Those words were never said aloud.

He has been gone many years. I often wonder if he sensed my unwillingness during our walks. If so, I just want to tell him how sorry I was and how I regretted it. Now I think of him when I complain about small affairs, when I am envious of others’ good fortune, when I don’t have a “good heart”.

At such times, I put my hand on his arm to regain my balance, and say, “You set the pace. I will try to adjust to you.”
