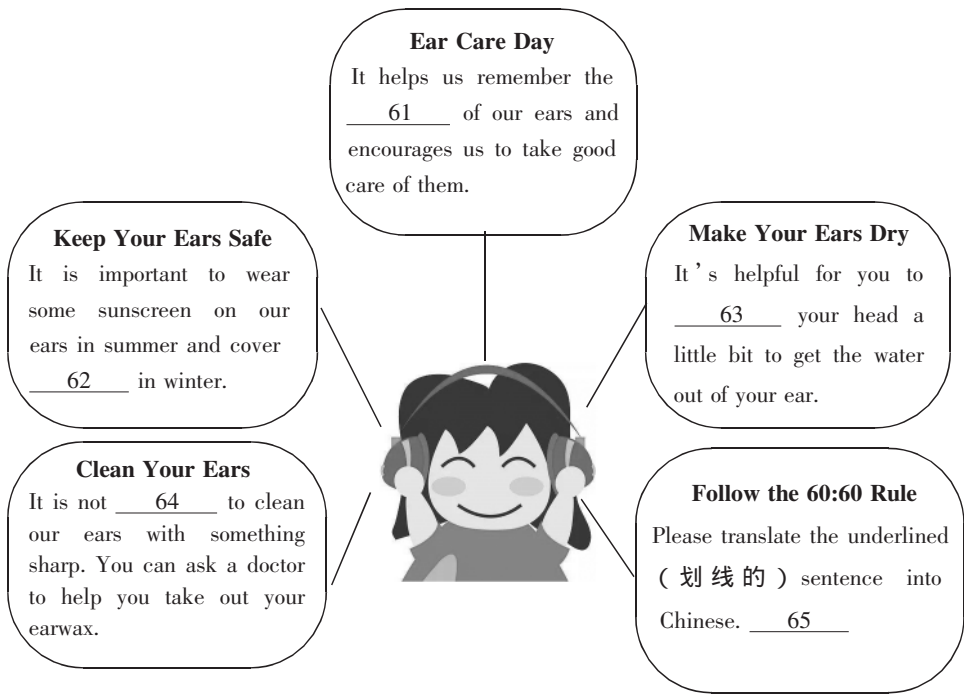

March 3 is Ear Care Day. It helps us remember the importance of our ears and encourages us to take good care of them.

The ears are truly important. Everyone should make sure to protect their own ears as well as they can.

Protect your ears

- When the sun is shining, wear some sunscreen (防晒霜) on your ears. And during the winter, cover your ears with a hat or a scarf.
- Dry your ears with a towel after swimming or having a bath. If you feel water in your ear, shake your head a little bit. This can help you get the water out of your ear.
- Don't clean your ears with your fingernails (指甲) or anything sharp. They can push earwax (耳屎) deep into your ear. If your earwax is making you uncomfortable, you can ask a doctor for help.
- Don't listen to music on your headphones for too long. Follow the 60:60 rule: listen to your music at 60 percent of the maximum volume (最大音量) for no more than 60 minutes a day.

Where to Go for Help


What should you do if you're a teenager under a lot of stress, or dealing with a mental health(心理健康) problem, and you don't have the money to see a doctor?

It is possible to find cheap, or sometimes free, mental health care and support. Let's see how teenagers in the US get help.

Free or low-cost counseling (咨询)

	School counselors(辅导员) and school psychologists (心理学家)
School counselors and psychologists can provide a good listening ear — for free! They can help you know the situation you're dealing with. If they can't help, you'll need to do a little more to find out how to get help.	

	Hospitals
Call your local hospital and ask what kinds of mental health services they offer, and at what price. Teaching hospitals, where doctors are trained, often provide low or no-cost services.	

	Local mental health centers and clinics (诊所)
These groups are helped by governments, so they charge (收费) less. Search online for "mental health services" and the name of the county or city where you live. One thing to keep in mind: Not every mental health clinic will fit your needs. Some might not work with people of your age. It's still worth(值得) a call, though. Even if a clinic can't help you, the people who work there might tell you someone who can.
