





One day a farmer from the countryside told the king that he could make the parrot fly. The king was very happy and invited him to the palace.

Pinhole projector Try this experiment and see an amazing world!	
	1. Push a drawing pin(图钉) into the middle of one end of a shoe box to make a hole. Push a pencil to widen it.
	2. Cut out a rectangular window at the other end of the box. Tape grease-proof paper (防油纸) over it.
	3. Cut another piece of grease proof paper big enough to cover the light-bulb (灯泡) end of a flashlight.
	4. Draw a triangle on the paper. Use pens to fill the triangle in dark green or blue and outline it in black. Make sure the triangle is slightly smaller than the circular edge of a flashlight.
	5. Tape the paper to the end of the flashlight. Switch on the flashlight and place it on a surface in a dark room.
	6. Stand one meter from the flashlight. Look through the viewer, pointing the pinhole at the light. What do you see?
Conclusions: Light from the flashlight passes through the pinhole onto your viewer. Light rays from the top of the flashlight hit the bottom of the viewer, and rays from the bottom hit the top. These rays cross over when they pass through the pinhole, so you see the triangle upside down.

Most parents hope that their children can be happy and successful. But what’s the most powerful way to encourage them to be so? The answer is to allow them to make their own decisions. But many parents make decisions for their children—What they wear, what they eat and what movies they watch.

In fact, it’s not good for children’s growing. Children should be allowed to make decisions when they are very young. But this doesn’t mean they are allowed to do everything. For example, you shouldn’t take your children into a store and tell them they can have anything they want. They would be **overwhelmed** by the choices. But you can give them a choice among snacks.

There are some ways for children to make their own decisions. The first step is to expand (扩大) the number of choices when children get older. For example, allow them to decide the activities they want to take part in or when they go to bed. The next step is to get your children to think before they act. Let them ask themselves several important questions. First, why do I want to do this? Second, what are my choices? Third, what are the results of the actions? After the three questions, they are sure to have right decisions.

Have you ever felt a video game was so good or important that it deserves some special honor? Maybe even a really big award? If so, The Strong National Museum of Play (国家电玩博物馆) agrees with you!

In 2015, the museum created the World Video Game Hall of Fame. Only the world’s best and most important video games are chosen to be a part of it. It’s a big honor. The Strong museum is in New York. Since it started the hall of fame, hundreds of games have been **nominated**. But only a few have received the honor. Among 2019’s Hall-of-Fame: *Super Mario Kart*, *Colossal Cave Adventure*, and *Microsoft Solitaire*.

The winners are not always new games. Often, they’re old-fashioned. People don’t play them anymore. But these games, which are milestones (里程碑) in the history of game development, have stood the test of time. And they are very important to the gaming world. Take *Colossal Cave Adventure* as an example. It’s a computer game from 1976. It helped start computer gaming. *Microsoft Solitaire* is a computer card game from 1991. Along with being fun, it taught computer users how to use a mouse. *Super Mario Kart*

came out way back in 1992. It was the first of the *Mario Kart* racing series. Fun fact: The game wasn't actually meant to include Mario. But a drawing of the famous plumber in the driver's seat turned out to be a hit. The rest is history!
