More and more people like to keep pets. In their eyes, keeping pets has many good points. It can teach people a sense of responsibility(责任感). What's more, it can drive away the loneliness. It can also lower people's stress. But I'd like to voice different opinions.

A recent survey showed that the common family spent more money on its pets than on its children. This can clearly be seen when we look at pet foods, which often have more vitamins(维生素)than human food. They certainly cost much. Last year, British families spent hundreds of million pounds on pet food, medicine or animal furniture(家具).

There are some reasons why I find pet-keeping worrying. They cause environmental problems. An example of this is New York. It is difficult to deal with the mess that dogs leave on the streets there. It can cause the environmental pollution. Many people find this funny, but in a number of large cities it is a big problem. Animals can cause illness, too.

Another problem is that pet owners don't have responsibility. Some owners leave their pets or can't look after them well. As a result, some pets die. Some are free to run everywhere. English farmers lose hundreds of sheep a year, killed by someone's pet and you must have read of children being hurt by some pets of their own.

If you want to keep a pet, prepare for it well. If you are keeping a pet, try to make yourself a better owner with more responsibility.

Waste sorting(垃圾分类) is a simple process that needs neither a lot of time, nor any special resources. When you throw away rubbish, do you know which bin(垃圾桶) it should go in? Have you ever noticed the differently-colored bins on the street or in your neighborhood?

Some of you might not be able to answer this question easily. In fact, it is very important. Not knowing how to sort waste can make it even harder to save energy and protect the environment.

If you don't sort your rubbish, all of it will go to a landfill(垃圾填埋场) and be mixed together. These landfills can take up large areas of ground that could have been used for planting trees or crops. The electronic(电子的) waste can pollute the earth and groundwater. Other pieces of rubbish, like the metal(金属的) part of a pen, can be used to make other things if they are properly reused.

With this in mind, many governments in China have run waste-sorting activities in recent years. For example, Shanghai said in July in 2019 that within three years, all of its people should sort their waste into four groups: wet, recyclable(可回收的), harmful(有害的) and dry. Shanghai has done well in the past one year. Following Shanghai, many other cities, including Shenzhen and Qingdao, plan to use this way to sort their waste. Now that you know this, perhaps you can do your part to protect the environment and encourage others to sort their rubbish.

Waste sorting is also one of the main problems around the world. Different countries are using different ways to sort their rubbish. Japan does the best in waste sorting in the world. It is a very important part of Japanese life and Japanese people will expect foreigners to follow their belief.
