The Coronavirus whistleblower Dr. Li Wenliang died of the virus on the night of February 6th. The 34-year-old doctor was working as an ophthalmologist(眼科医生) at Wuhan Central Hospital when he sent out a warning to fellow medics on December 30th. He was one of the first eight doctors who warned of the new virus and was blamed in early January by local police for “publishing rumors(谣言).” He first posted about the coronavirus in his medical schoolmate WeChat group. “I only wanted to remind my university classmates to be careful,” he said. The Wuhan doctor is widely regarded as a hero, and a number of posts on Chinese social media sites have expressed **grief** over his death.

When Randy Heiss went hiking behind his Patagonia, Ariz farm, the last thing he expected to find was a Christmas list from a little girl across the US-Mexico border(边境). “I found this balloon on my morning walk near Patagonia on Sunday. Attached(系上) to it was a piece of paper with the Christmas wishes from a little girl,” Heiss wrote on his Facebook page.

When he brought the list home to his wife, who speaks Spanish well, they discovered that the little girl had asked for toys, clothes, art supplies(美术用品) and many other gifts. That's when Heiss set out to make the little girl's Christmas dreams come true. Heiss said he had tried to send Christmas letters to Santa Claus by balloon when he was a kid, but never received a reply.

Heiss sent a Facebook message on Wednesday to XENY, a radio station in Nogales, to see if it could help him find out the girl or her family. He later received a reply from the station, which was sure that the writer of the letter was an 8-year-old girl named Dayami. And the station wanted to set up a meeting between the two on Thursday. "It just changed my whole day, " Heiss told the Washington Post. " Instead

Seventeen-year-old Sariah Estrada didn't expect to receive anything in return when she saved a *drowning*(溺水的) man on Marianne Beach in Blanchisseuse earlier this year.

However, for her act of kindness, Estrada was awarded the Hummingbird Medal-Bronze for her courage on Monday, September 24. President Paula-Mae Weeks gave the national award to her.

In July of this year, Estrada along with two friends went to the Marianne Beach to relax. Upon leaving the beach, Estrada and her friends noticed a man struggling in the water. She and her friends took actions at once. The teens borrowed a board from some people on the beach and swam to save the man's life.

She said when they reached the man, he was already *unconscious* (不省人事的) and they pulled him out of the water on the body board. Estrada remembered what she learned during a life-saving course the week before and quickly started *pumping* (按压)

the man's chest. After several times, she was successful and the young man's life was saved.

In an interview, the teenager said while she is thankful for the award, she wasn't expecting anything in return.

"This award was never expected because I thought of helping someone as an act of *humanity*(人道) and never looked for anything in return, but the award is well appreciated. As I reflect on the action I took, I felt as though I could help this person as I have the proper training. The week before it I took part in a basic life support-training course," Estrada explained. She said she plans to continue helping people.

The national award receiver also had this message for the young people of Trinidad and Tobago.

"I would like to encourage the young people of Trinidad and Tobago to fight for being excellent. Never sell yourself short by believing that you cannot do what you wish. All things are possible and hard work surely brings success."
